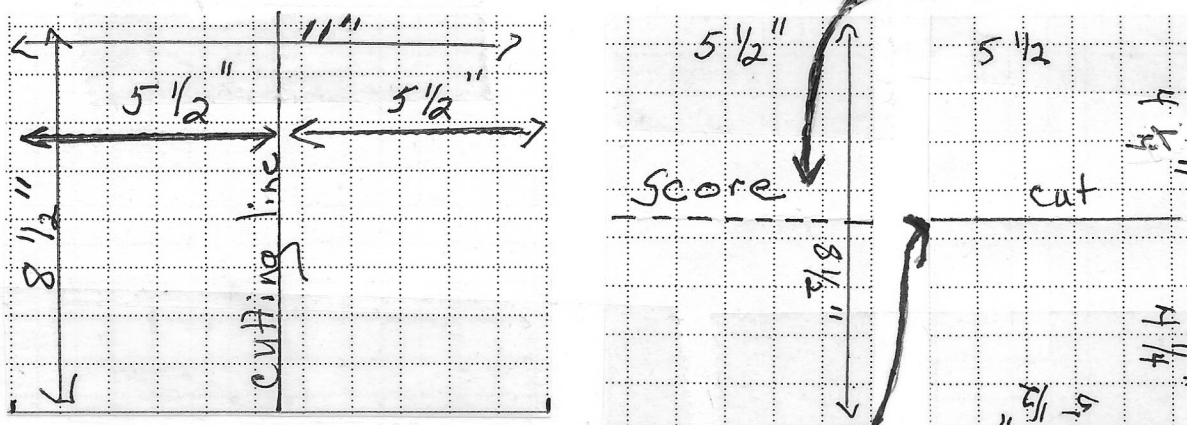


Instructions as how to make the All You Are Birthday Card

The first step is to cut a card base from a sheet of thick Wisper White Cardstock measuring $8\frac{1}{2}$ " by 11".

Cut the 11" side in half. Take one of the two pieces of cardstock and score one at $4\frac{1}{4}$ ". Fold the card base on the score line and you should have a card base of $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".



With the other half of the sheet of cardstock, cut it in half on the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " side which will leave you with two quarter sheets to use for stamping the images.

Next cut a length of Highland Heather Gala Gingham about $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by $3\frac{3}{4}$ ".

You will also need a scrap of Heather Highland Cardstock about 2" by 2" to stamp the Happy Birthday sentiment. The last cardstock you will need is 4 " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " piece of Highland Heather cardstock.

On one $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by $5\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of Wisper White Cardstock, stamp the flower image in the center of the cardstock or slightly toward the upper edge. Bear in mind this image will be cut out with the 2nd largest rectangle stitched framelits.

Stamp the Happy Birthday on the 2" by 2" scrap of Highland Heather. It will need to be centered as well, so you can use the smaller "fat" framelit to cut out Happy Birthday with. The last thing to stamp is the other piece of Wisper White cardstock $4\frac{1}{4}$ " by $5\frac{1}{2}$ " for the inside. Stamp your sentiment and flower at the bottom right hand corner of the cardstock leaving enough of a border to cut this piece out with the largest rectangle framelit.

Now you are ready to use the Stampin' Blends to color your images. After you have finished that, cut out your images with the proper rectangle framelits. The largest framelit is for the inside of the card with the small flower image, the 2nd largest is for the flower that goes on the front of the card and the final small framelit that I call the "fat one" is for the Happy Birthday.

Put glue on the back of the gingham piece and adhere near the bottom of the flower piece that goes on the front of the card. Now glue that piece onto the Highland Heather piece. Finally adhere to the front of the card. Lastly adhere the inside piece with the small flower to the inside of the card. Now all you have to do is I adhere the Happy Birthday sentiment onto the front of the card with dimensionals.
