

To Make This Card You Will Need the Following Items

Paper

- 1 piece of Whisper White cardstock measuring 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" for card base
- 2 pieces of Blueberry Bushel cardstock measuring 4" x 5 1/4"
- 1 pieces of Crumb Cake Cardstock measuring 3 ¾" x 5" for layering
- 1 piece of Pressed Petals Specialty DSP measuring 3 ½"x 4 ¾"
- 1 piece of Blueberry Bushel 1 ¾" x 3 ¾"
- 1 piece of Whisper White for label 3" x 3"
- 1 piece of Crumb Cake for label about 3" x 3"
- 1 piece of Crumb Cake for die cut outs about 5" x 5" should be enough (one for the butterfly and one for the railing)

Stamp Set & Die

- Painted Bitty Birthday Cling Stamp
- Itty Bitty Birthday Stamps
- Special Celebrations Stamp
- Stained Glass Dies

Punches

- Pretty Label Punch

Ink

- Blueberry Bushel Ink Pad

Adhesive

- Tombow Liquid Multipurpose Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Adhesive Strips
- Sizzix Adhesive Sheets (not available at Stampin UP)
- Post It Tape (Not available at Stampin UP)

Embellishments

- Nobel Peacock Rhinestones

Tools

- Some Kind of Paper Cutter Stampin' UP no longer sales one
- Stamaparatus or Clear Acrylic Block E is good for a lot of stampin projects
- Bone Folder
- Scissors
- Big Shot or other die cutting machine (Stampin' UP has stopped selling this item as well)

Pick Your Tool

Simple Shammy- This is great to clean stamps especially photopolymer or cling stamps

Instructions

Step 1. Cut all the pieces according to the measurements except the pieces that have to be cut with a die.

Step 2. Use the Blueberry Bushel Ink pad to stamp the following items. Stamp the Happy Birthday sentiment from the Itty Bitty Birthday Stamp set onto a piece of thick Whisper White big enough to punch out the Pretty Punch Label from. Also, stamp the inside card sentiment onto the piece of Crumb Cake Cardstock measuring 3 ¾" x 5". Stamp the little flower down in the right corner of the same piece of cardstock. Now stamp the butterfly on a scrap of Crumb Cake and lay aside.

Step 3. Punch out the label with the Happy Birthday stamped on it with the Pretty Label Punch. Also punch out another label from a piece of Crumb Cake Cardstock.

Step 4. Cut a piece of Crumb Cake Cardstock big enough for the long die and then cut another piece of Sizzix adhesive sheet the same size. Remove one side of protective covering and adhere to the back of the Crumb Cake Cardstock. If you do not have any adhesive sheets you may skip this step and carefully use glue instead in the step where you are gluing the railing to the Blueberry Bushel Cardstock.

Step 5. Now lay the long die on a piece of Crumb Cake Cardstock and run through the die cutting machine. Lay the die to cut out the butterfly on the stamped butterfly lining it up so that it has a narrow border all the way around it. Tape with Post It tape to hold in place and run through the die cutting machine. Remove any loose pieces and lay aside.

Step 6. Now it is time to assembly. In this particular video, I completed the inside first which is perfectly acceptable. Take the piece of stamped Crumb Cake and glue to one piece of the Blueberry Bushel Cardstock. Then take the glued piece and put a little glue on the back and adhere it to the inside of the card base.

Step 7. Glue the Pressed Petal DSP(designer series paper) to the other piece of Blueberry Bushel cardstock. Lay aside. Next take the strip of Blueberry Bushel cardstock measuring 1 ¾" x 3 ¾" and glue the railing in the center of it. If you use Sizzix Adhesive Sheets, you will need to remove the protective covering and just place the railing on the strip of Blueberry Bushel which is easier. **Some people use sponges to put the glue on tiny pieces of cardstock.** It's your choice. Now glue that piece to the center of the card front.

Step 8. Cut the Crumb Cake label in half horizontally. Put a little glue on the backside of the Whisper White Happy Birthday label and place half of the Crumb Cake label under it leaving a small border. Now do the other half of the Crumb Cake label the same way.

Step 9. Put dimensionals on the back of your sentiment label. Remove protective coverings and place label in center of front Blueberry Bushel Border with railing. Add three of the Nobel Peacock Rhinestones in the Blueberry Bushel color on your label. Cut a tiny piece of adhesive strip to put down the body of the butterfly on the underneath side. Remove protective strip and place butterfly on a flower on your card or just in the upper right corner. Add a few Nobel Peacock Rhinestones and your butterfly will take on a new beauty.
