

To Make This Card You Will Need the Following Items

Paper

1 piece of Whisper White cardstock measuring 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" for card base

Small scrap of Whisper White to cut the sentiment from

2 pieces of Purple Posy cardstock measuring 3 ¾" x 5"

2 pieces of Gorgeous Grape cardstock measuring 4" x 5 1/4"

1 piece of Gorgeous Grape measuring ¼" x 5"

1 piece of Gorgeous Grape measuring about 5 ½" x 8 ½" or some scraps to cut the Daisy out of and the circle to go under the doily

1 piece of Designer Series Paper measuring 1 ¼" x 5"

Stamp Set & Die

Daisy Delight Photopolymer Stamp Set

Healing Hugs Cling Stamp Set (Sentiment for inside of card-optional)

Well Said Cling Stamp Set (For the Get Well Sentiment)

Daisy Punch

Layering Circle Dies

Smooth Sailing Dies (to cut out the sentiment on the front)

Ink Pad

Gorgeous Grape Ink Pad

Embellishments

Clear Faceted Gems

Pearlized Doilies

Adhesive

Tombow Liquid Multipurpose Glue

Stampin Dimensionals

Some Kind of Paper Cutter Stampin' UP no longer sales one

Stamaparatus or Clear Acrylic Block E is good for a lot of stampin projects

Big Shot or other die cutting machine (Stampin' UP has stopped selling this item as well)

Pick Your Tool

Simple Shammy- This is great to clean stamps especially photopolymer or cling stamps

Instructions

Step 1. Cut all the pieces according to the measurements **except** the pieces that have to be cut with a die.

Step 2. Using the Gorgeous Grape Ink Pad, stamp the Get Well on the small piece of Whisper White Cardstock. Then take the daisy stamp and stamp **two** daisies on the Gorgeous Grape Cardstock measuring 5 ½" by 8 1/2". Remember to keep them close together on the paper so you have enough paper left to cut the large smooth circle out of Gorgeous Grape Cardstock. Go ahead and stamp the little flowers on one of the Purple Posy Cardstock pieces measuring 3 ¾" x 5". First stamp the more distinct design, then use the smooth stamp to stamp over the distinct design. **I stamped off once on a scrap piece of paper, then stamped over the flower design.** You will also need to stamp one flower in the lower left corner of the other sheet of Purple Posy Cardstock that will go inside the card. If you are going to put the inside sentiment on the card go ahead and stamp it now.

Step 3. Take the Daisy Punch, being careful to line up the daisies properly and punch out the two stamped daisies. Place the largest smooth circle die on the Gorgeous Grape Cardstock that is left from cutting out the daisies and run through the die machine. Also use the die from the Smooth Sailing die set and cut out the Get Well sentiment.

Step 4. Now we are ready to assembly. First take the designers series paper measuring 1 ¼" x 5" and glue it to the bottom of the Purple Posy piece that you stamped all the little flowers on. Next take the ¼" x 5" piece of Gorgeous Grape and glue it just above the DSP. Now glue the Purple Posy piece of cardstock with all the little flowers on it to one of the Gorgeous Grape Cardstock pieces.

Step 5. Take the two daisies and using a pencil, paint brush handle or just something small and round that you can curl the petals just a bit. I curled these under. Place a Stampin Dimensional in the center of one of the daisies. Remove the covering and place the other daisy on top of the dimensional offsetting the petals to make the flower look full. Lay aside.

Step 6. Put a little glue on the back of the pearlized doily and glue to the round Gorgeous Grape Circle. Put a little glue on the back of this union and glue to the card front balancing the spacing above and below the circle.

Step 7. Take the daisy and put another dimensional on the underneath side of the flower and after removing the protective covering place it in the center of the doily. Lastly take one large clear faceted gem and place in the middle of the flower.

Step 8. Glue your sentiment into place in the lower right corner.

Step 9. Take your inside sentiment piece of Purple Posy and glue to the last piece of Gorgeous Grape and then glue this union to the card base.

This makes a really nice card to send to someone and if you prefer other colors, you can coordinate any colors you like and still have a pretty card. I hope you enjoyed this project.
