

To Make This Card You Will Need the Following Items

Paper

- 1 piece of thick Whisper White Cardstock cut to 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" for card base
- 2 pieces of Calypso Coral Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼" for layering
- 1 piece of Calypso Coral Cardstock measuring 4" x 5"
- 1 piece of Calypso Coral Cardstock measuring 2 ½" x 3" to cut layer to go under front sentiment
- 1 piece of thick Whisper White Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼" for layering on the inside of the card base
- 1 piece of Whisper White measuring 4" x 5" to stamp front image on
- 1 piece of Whisper White measuring 2 ½" x 3" for the front sentiment
- 1 piece of Champagne foil cut to 4 ¼" x 5 ½" for embossing
- 1 scrap of Calypso Coral to cut 2 sprigs from

Some kind of Paper Cutter-**Stampin' Up no longer sells a paper cutter**

Some kind of Die Cutting Machine-**Stampin Up' does not sell a die cutting machine at this time**

Directions for Card Assembly

Step 1. Cut all your cardstock according to measurements above except pieces to go through die cutting machine.

Step 2. Take the piece of Whisper White measuring 4" x 5" and position in your stamparatus. Now rub the embossing buddy over your paper to make sure there isn't any static on it. Now position your milk can stamp on the cardstock. Leave a border at the bottom so you have enough room to place the stitched rectangle die. Using the Versamark Ink pad cover the stamp and stamp onto the cardstock. You may need to do this twice to make sure you have good coverage. Look at the stamped area at an angle to make you can see your image. Take the silver embossing powder and sprinkle all over your image. Thump the paper or turn from side to side to make sure it sticks to all stamped areas. Now remove the excess powder by thumbing the cardstock over another piece of cardstock to catch it. You can use this again by putting back in the jar. You may want to blow the few grains of powder away before you heat it. Turn on the heat tool and let it get good and warm, then holding it above your image, allow the heat to melt the powder. As soon as the embossing powder melts move on to another area. Do not overheat. The powder will turn shiny when melted.

Step 3. Clean the milk can image and put away. Put the flower image back on the stamparatus and position again. Run the embossing buddy back over your cardstock where the flower image is going. Take the image with the flowers and cotton and position just above the milk can. Now use the Versamark Ink again and cover the flower image. This time use gold embossing powder instead of silver and repeat the process.

Step 4. Take the piece of Whisper White measuring 2 ½" x 3" and position on the Stamparatus. Stamp the sentiment "Simply Thankful for All the Good Things" in Calypso Coral Ink. Once this is dry take the embossing buddy and rub across the cardstock to remove any static. Now clean your stamp leaving it in the same position and then coat it with the Versamark Ink. Sprinkle **Clear** embossing powder covering it well. Remove the excess embossing powder and then using the heat tool melt the embossing powder. Now you have the color that matches your paper and it will have a pretty shine.

Step 5. Stamp the sprig stamp from the First Frost Cling Stamp set on the piece of Whisper White Cardstock measuring 3 ¾" x 5".

Step 6. Color the flower images with So Saffron for the small flower in the center. Color the Sunflowers with the Calypso Coral, the leaves with Garden Green and the berries with Highland Heather or Gorgeous Grape. **Whatever colors you choose to use make sure you blot off the image when done as the water based markers will not absorb into the embossing and you make streak color across your card if you do not blot it!**

Step 7. Now it is time to use your die cutting machine. First take the Tin Tile Dynamic Embossing Folder and place the piece of Champagne Foil inside it and run through your die cutting machine. Trim to 3 ¾" x 5".

Step 8. Take the 4th rectangle stitched die from the outside of the big set and lay on top of the colored image. Make sure you balance everything nicely, then run through the die cutting machine.

Step 9. Take the piece of Calypso Coral Cardstock measuring 4" x 5" and using the 3rd largest stitched rectangle die cut out a layer to put under image.

Step 10. Now take the rectangle sentiment die from the Frosted Bouquet dies and cut out the front sentiment as well as the layer to go under it from the piece of Calypso Coral Cardstock measuring 2 ½" x 3".

Step 11. Lastly cut two sprigs using the die from the Frosted Bouquet die set from scraps of the Calypso Coral.

Step 12. Time to assemble. Take the piece of Whisper White Cardstock with the sprig stamped on it and glue to the piece of Calypso Coral measuring 4"x 5 ¼". Now glue this unit to the inside of the card base on the right half.

Step 13. Now glue the champagne foil piece that has been trimmed to 3 ¾" x 5" and glue to the Calypso Coral piece measuring 4"x 5 ¼". Glue the milk can piece to the Calypso Coral piece

that was cut out with the rectangle die. Now glue this piece to the piece with the champagne embossed piece.

Step 14. Glue the sentiment piece to the layering piece of the Calypso Coral that is the same shape just slightly bigger.

Step 15. Now position the two sprigs and the sentiment on the front of the card and get an idea of where you want to place them. Glue the sprigs into place. Now put Stampin Dimensionals on the back of your sentiment piece. Remove coverings and stick to the lower right side of your card.

This card can be sent to almost anyone and you have room to write a note!
