

To Make This Card You Will Need the Following Items

Paper

- 1 piece of Pretty Peacock Paper measuring 4 ¼" x 9 ½"
- Cut 4 pieces of Brightly Gleaming Designer Paper 2 3/8" x 3 ¾"
- Cut 2 pieces of Brightly Gleaming Designer Paper 1 ¼" x 3 ¾"
- Cut pieces of Brightly Gleaming Designer Paper 1 1/8" x 3 ¾"
- 1 Piece of Whisper White to stamp delivery man on, then cut to 2" x about 4"
- 1 - 8 ½" piece of Very Vanilla Ribbon

Directions for Card Assembly

Step 1. Cut your paper to the measurements above.

Step 2. Score your piece of Pretty Peacock Paper at 1 5/8", 4 1/4", 5 5/8", and 7"

Step 3. Stamp your delivery man on the Whisper White Paper. Be mindful that your paper will be cut to 2" wide after stamping so position the little empty box fairly close to the chest of the delivery man. You can stamp your sentiment at the same time as the delivery man, but the little box and hearts will have to be done in a separate step.

Step 4. Cut the Whisper White to 2" wide. Use the Scalloped Tag Topper to finish top of tag. Also trim the bottom of the tag.

Step 5. Color the delivery man with the blends as shown.

Step 6. Use the Trio Punch to round the corners of the one side of the DSP measuring 1 1/4" x 3 3/4", as well as the one side of **two** pieces of DSP measuring 2 3/8" x 3 3/4". Now round the ends of the Pretty Peacock Paper.

Step 7. Make a mountain of the 5 5/8" score line. The mountain need to be formed toward the inside of the gift card holder. This will be the part that hold

your gift card on the inside. Burnish the 1 5/8" folding toward the inside as well as the 7" score line.

Step 8. Glue the DSP to the Pretty Peacock. Match the rounded corners to the proper places. Do this on the inside and outside of gift card holder.

Step 9. Place a piece of Tear & Tape and place on the edge of the 7" score line toward the center of the gift card holder. Remove the protective covering and adhere to the 4 1/4" score line. Now your card holder is standing up on the inside of the gift card holder even though it is closed at this point.

Step 10. Cut a sliver off the closed edge to open up a place to hold the gift card. Also take a 1/2 width bite using the Pretty Label Punch. You may have to press really hard to get through the thick layers.

Step 11. Fold up gift card holder slip ribbon through tag. Wrap ribbon around gift card holder and lap under the tag. Secure using a couple of glue dots.

That is all there is to it.
