

To Make This Card You Will Need the Following Items

Paper

- 1 piece of thick Very Vanilla 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" for card base
- 2 pieces of Shaded Spruce cut to 4" x 5 ¼" for layering
- 1 piece of Whisper White cut to 4" x 5" to cut Stitched Nested Label and Merry Christmas from
- 1 piece of Regals DSP measuring 3 ¾" x 5"
- 1 piece of thick Whisper White measuring 3 ¾" x 5" for inside sentiment

Stamp Set

- Rustic Retreat Cling Stamp Set
- Christmas Gleaming Cling Set
- Merry Christmas To All Photopolymer Set

Die

- Stitched Nested Labels Dies

Ink

- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad
- Shaded Spruce Classic Stampin' Pad

Markers

- Many Marvelous Markers (Shaded Spruce, Mint Macaron , Gray Granite, Soft Suede, So Saffron

Ribbon

- Whisper White 5/8" Polka Dot Tulle 6"-7"
- Some kind of ½" White Ribbon 6"-7"

Adhesive

- Tombow Liquid Multipurpose Glue
- Stampin' Dimensionals'
- Mini Glue Dots

Tools

Stamparatus

Bone Folder

Big Shot or some kind of Die Cutting Machine-(Stampin' UP no longer sells a die cutting machine) I recommend an electric one. I love mine!

Scissors

Paper Trimmer (You can cut and score with this **New** improved Stampin Trimmer)

Take Your Pick Tool

Simply Shammy for cleaning stamps

Directions for Card Assembly

Step 1. Cut and score all your cardstock according to measurements above.

Step 2. Stamp the cabin image on your piece of Whisper White Card Stock measuring 4" x 5. Also stamp the inside sentiment on the 3 ¾" x 5" of Whisper White. Lastly stamp the Merry Christmas sentiment on a scrap of Whisper White. After you stamp the Merry Christmas either cut it out leaving a border or cut next to the green and place on a separate piece of Whisper White. Your label needs to end up being about ½" x 2".

Step 3. Color your cabin with the markers listed above and cut out with the Stitched Label die.

Step 4. Glue your checked DSP onto one of your Shaded Spruce pieces. Next cut about 6" or a little more of ribbon. Place in the center of your card and secure on the back side with scotch tape. I used one layer of Whisper White 5/8" Polka Dot Tulle Ribbon and some Whisper White ribbon that I had. Use whatever you want to match the card. You will also need to tie a small bow.

Step 5. Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of your label and place over your ribbon on the left side of the front.

Step 6. Glue this unit to the card front.

Step 7. Glue on Merry Christmas.

Step 8. Using a glue dot attach the bow to the right side of label.

Step 9. Glue the inside sentiment to the other piece of Shaded Spruce Cardstock and then glue this unit to the inside of the card base.
