

To Make This Card You Will Need the Following Items

Paper

1 piece of Cherry Cobbler Cardstock cut to 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼" for card base

1 piece of Sparkle Glimmer paper cut to 4" x 5 ¼" for layering (My Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer paper has been replaced with this)

1 piece of Wrapped in Plaid DSP cut to 3 ¾" x 5" for front of card

1 piece of Whisper White Thick Cardstock measuring 3 ¾" x 5" for sentiment on inside of card

A small piece of Cherry Cobbler to cut decorative corner pieces for inside of card

1-4" by 4" piece of Sparkle Glimmer paper to cut large deer from

½" x 3 ¾" piece of Whisper White to stamp Merry Christmas on

¾" x 3 ¾" piece of Cherry Cobbler to put behind sentiment piece

Stamp Set

Cherry Cobbler Classic Stampin' Pad

Bone Folder

Big Shot or some kind of Die Cutting Machine-(Stampin' UP no longer sells a die cutting machine) I recommend an electric one. I love mine!

Scissors

Paper Trimmer (You can cut and score with this **New** improved Stampin Trimmer)

Simply Shammy for cleaning stamps

Directions for Card Assembly

Step 1. Cut and score all your cardstock according to measurements above.

Step 2. Stamp all the sentiments with Cherry Cobbler, one Merry Christmas for the front of the card and the larger sentiment on the piece of Whisper White Thick Cardstock measuring $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" for the inside of the card. Note you may want to stamp Merry Christmas on a larger piece of Whisper White, then trim to $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Step 3. Cut out the large deer out of the Sparkle Glimmer paper by running the die through the die machine. Also cut the inside decorative corner pieces from the Cherry Cobbler cardstock.

Step 4. Glue the Wrapped In Plaid DSP (deer design) to the Sparkle Glimmer paper cut to 4" x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " for layering. Now glue the Merry Christmas sentiment onto the piece of Cherry Cobbler measuring $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Step 5. Lay your sentiment piece and deer on the front of your card to position before gluing. Once satisfied, glue into place. Now take this completed front piece and adhere to the card base with glue.

Step 6. Glue the inside sentiment to the card base. Next put a small amount of glue on the flower corner pieces and glue in opposite corners.

A very simple and pretty card!
