

To Make This Card You Will Need The Following Items

Paper

½ sheet of an 8 ½” by 11” Very Vanilla Thick Cardstock cut to 8 ½” by 5 ½”
(score at 4 ¼”)

2 pieces of Very Vanilla Cardstock cut 3 ¾” x 5”

2 pieces of Evening Evergreen Cardstock cut to 4” by 5 ¼”

1 piece of Very Vanilla Thick Cardstock cut about 2 ½” x 5”

1 piece of Evening Evergreen Cardstock cut about 2 ½” x 5”

Stamps & Dies

Stampin’ UP does not sell these but they are very helpful in card making

Reverse tweezers with pointed tip

Xyron adhesive eraser

Tombow Mono sand and rubber eraser combo

Instructions

1. Cut cardstock first and lay aside.
2. Clean one piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock cut 3 ¾” x 5” of any static with embossing buddy
3. Stamp the outside images on this piece of cardstock using the Versa Mark Ink Pad
4. Sprinkle Gold embossing powder over the images. Tap the back of the cardstock piece to remove excess embossing powder
5. Turn Heat Tool on high and let warm up
6. Hold heat tool above or to the side of the cardstock and watch the magic happen. The gold powder melts and turns into a shiny gold. As soon as one area is melted move to an area that is not melted. Don’t hold heat tool over melted area too long. It just needs to melt.
7. Repeat the process with the outside sentiment using the Very Vanilla Thick Cardstock cut about 2 ½” x 5”.
8. Next stamp the inside sentiment with Early Espresso Ink as well as a partial image of the fall image.
9. Glue the outside piece of cardstock with the gold image to a piece of the Evening Evergreen cardstock. Now glue to the front of the card base.

10. Next cut out the outside sentiment piece as well as the smaller Evening Evergreen with the same die. Cut the Evening Evergreen piece lengthwise with a pair of scissors. You should have two pieces roughly the same size. Now put a little glue on the upper under edge of the sentiment piece and carefully lay on top of one piece of the Evening Evergreen piece leaving a border around your sentiment. If you have difficulty visualizing this refer to the video. Do the same thing for the bottom of the sentiment. Lay aside. (Note if you do not have a Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine, you can always cut a rectangle and cut a second rectangle a little larger to act as a border.)
11. Glue the inside sentiment piece to the last piece of Evening Evergreen Cardstock cut to 4" by 5 1/4". Then glue to the inside of the card base.
12. Lastly add dimensionals to the back side of the sentiment piece. Remove protective covering and then glue to the front of the card.

This makes a beautiful card that is really quite easy to make!
