

## To Make This Card You Will Need The Following Items

### Paper

½ sheet of an 8 ½" by 11" Basic White Cardstock cut to 8 ½" by 5 ½"  
(score at 4 ¼")

1 pieces of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" by 5 "

2 pieces of Real Red Cardstock cut to 4" by 5 1/4"

1 piece of Real Red Cardstock cut to 2 7/8" x 3 ¾"

1 small piece of Real Red to cut the nose of the deer from

Cut a piece of Real Red cardstock 5/8" x 2 5/8" to put behind the sentiment

Cut 1 piece of Basic White Cardstock to 3/8" x 2 5/8" after you stamp Merry Christmas on it.

1 Piece of Soft Suede about 2 ½" x 3" to stamp deer on

1 small piece Early Espresso for the deer antlers

1 piece of Crumb Cake cardstock cut to 2 5/8" x 3 3/4"

1 piece of patterned DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 3 ¾" x 5"

1 piece of patterned DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 2 3/8" x 6" if you want to decorate back flap of envelope

Reverse tweezers with pointed tip

Xyron adhesive eraser

Tombow Mono sand and rubber eraser combo

1. As always cut your cardstock with the exception of the sentiment piece for Merry Christmas.
2. Stamp the deer using the Early Espresso Ink pad on the piece of Soft Suede 2 ½" x 3"
3. Stamp the stars in Early Express on the piece of Crumb Cake cardstock cut to 2 5/8" x 3 ¾
4. Stamp the Merry Christmas on a piece of Basic White cardstock using the Real Red Ink pad and then cut to 3/8" x 2 5/8"
5. Stamp the inside sentiment with either Real Red or Early Espresso ink on the Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" by 5. Also stamp the small image in the left hand corner with Early Espresso
6. Using the punch cut out the deer, the antlers from a scrap of Early Espresso, and the nose from a scrap of Real Red cardstock.
7. Glue piece of Crumb Cake cardstock cut to 2 5/8" x 3 ¾" with stars on it to the Real Red Cardstock cut to 2 7/8" x 3 3/4"
8. Glue the Basic White Cardstock cut to 3/8" x 2 5/8" with Merry Christmas on it to the Real Red cardstock 5/8" x 2 5/8
9. Glue the deer to the lower part of the piece with stars. Next glue on the antlers and nose.
10. Glue the sentiment just above the deer dividing the distance
11. Glue the striped DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 3 ¾" x 5" to one piece of the Real Red Cardstock cut to 4" by 5 1/4"
12. Glue the front deer panel to the striped/real red piece.
13. Glue this piece to the card base front.
14. Glue the inside sentiment piece to the last piece of Real Red cardstock and then glue to the inside of the card base.

## Envelope

Using your tape runner put tape on the top side of the flap of the envelope. Carefully lay your piece of DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 2 3/8" x 6" on the flap starting at the fold of the flap. Trim and you are done!
