

This is What You Will Need For The Delicate Dahlia Inspiration Card

Paper

- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored at 4 1/4"
- 2 pieces of Basic White Cardstock cut to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (one for stamping flower & one for cutting scalloped panel from-- use **largest** scalloped die in the Stitched So Sweetly set)
- 1 pieces of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 3/4" x 5" for the inside of card
- 1 piece of Basic Black cut to 4" x 5 1/4" for the inside border
- 1 piece of Basic Black cut to 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" to cut stitched rectangle from (use **second** largest die)
- 1 piece of Basic Black cut to 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" for the front of the card
- 1 small piece of Basic Black to stamp sentiment on
- 1 piece of Beautifully Penned, (Polka Dot) measuring 2 3/8" x 6"

Stamparatus or choose acrylic blocks(a,b,c,e are recommended by Stampin' UP)

Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine will work for this project

Instructions

1. Fold and burnish on the score line of your card base. Burnish simply means to run a bone folder over the fold of your card.
2. Measure and cut the pieces of cardstock.
3. Using proper dies cut the scalloped piece and the stitched rectangle.

4. Stamp the Dahlia with Calypso Coral using your Stamparatus or an acrylic block. This is a two step process. Stamp the outline first and the inside on top of the outline.
5. Fussy cut the Dahlia out and put dimensionals on the back of it.
6. Stamp a leaf in **three** of the corners of the scalloped piece of Basic White. Also stamp a green leaf in the lower right corner of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" x 5" for the inside of card. Lay aside.
7. Take your small piece of Basic Black and clean static away with the embossing buddy by rubbing across cardstock.
8. Stamp sentiment using the Versa Mark Ink Pad. Now sprinkle white embossing powder and cover completely. Turn over and tap back of cardstock to remove excess powder. Be sure to catch extra embossing powder and put back in your jar. Now melt powder with heat tool.
9. Cut to ½" wide and round ends with the Treasured Tags Punch.
10. Now you are ready to assemble. Take the Basic White Scalloped piece and glue to the stitched rectangle piece. Next glue this piece to the Polka Dot DSP from the Beautifully Penned pack. Next you will glue this to the piece of Basic Black cut to 4 1/8" x 5 3/8". Finally glue to the front of the card base. Your border of black and the card base are very thin.
11. Remove the dimensional backs and place flower over the three leaves.
12. Put dimensionals on the sentiment and place in upper right corner of scalloped piece. You may need to cut dimensionals in half.

Inside

Glue the piece of the Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" x 5" with the green leaf to the piece of Basic Black cut to 4" x 5 1/4 ". Finally glue this piece to the inside of the card base.

Envelope

Using your tape runner put tape on the top side of the flap of the envelope. Carefully lay your piece of DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 2 3/8" x 6" on the flap starting at the fold of the flap. Trim and you are done!

Stampin' UP does not sell these but they are very helpful in card making

Tombow Mono sand and rubber eraser combo

Adhesive Remover (2"x2" block")
