

# **This is What You Will Need For The Twin Bell Christmas Card**

## **Paper**

1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 5 ½” x 8 ½” scored at 4 ¼”  
3 pieces of Real Red Cardstock cut to 4” x 5 ¼”  
1 pieces of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾” x 5” for the inside  
1 pieces of Basic White Cardstock cut to 1” x 5 ½” for top border cut out  
1 small piece of Basic White Cardstock to stamp the sentiment on about 2” x 2”  
1 Piece of Old Olive Cardstock cut 3 ¾” x 5”  
1 Piece of Polka Dot Gingerbread and Peppermint DSP cut 3 ¾” x 5”  
2 very narrow width pieces of Black Glitter Paper approximately 2” long ( will a just length with applying to the card)

1 piece of Polka Dot Gingerbread and Peppermint DSP paper measuring 2 3/8” x 6” if you want to decorate back flap of envelope

## **Ink**

Real Red Ink Pad  
Tuxedo Black Momento Ink Pad

Mini Ruffled Real Red Ribbon

## **Adhesive**

Multipurpose Glue  
Stampin’ Seal  
Glue Dots

## **Tools**

Take Your Pick Tool  
Paper Trimmer  
Scissors  
Stamparatus or Acrylic Block E  
Bone Folder  
Simple Bone Folder  
Mini Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine will work for this project

## Instructions

1. Fold and burnish on the score line of your card base. Burnish simply means to run a bone folder over the fold of your card.
2. Measure and cut the pieces of cardstock. Cut out the bells using the outside ring of the bell die from 1 Piece of Old Olive Cardstock cut 3 ¾" x 5"(turn cardstock horizontally). as if you were cutting out a solid bell. Run through your die cutting machine.
3. Also cut the top border piece using the die and Basic White Cardstock cut to 1" x 5 ½". Remove all loose pieces.
4. Cut two borders of the bells from one piece of Real Red Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼ ". If you have scrap pieces big enough cut them from scraps instead of a quarter sheet of Real Red Cardstock. No need to waste paper.
5. Stamp the sentiment Wishing You A Merry Christmas in Real Red ink on the 2" x 2" piece of Basic White Cardstock. Also stamp the inside sentiment on 1 pieces of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" x 5. You may stamp the stars in the corner with Tuxedo Black Momento Ink.
6. Cut the words Merry Christmas from the sentiment Wishing You A Merry Christmas.
7. Glue the Old Olive piece with the bells cut out to the Polka Dotted Piece. Glue the Real Red Bell borders to the bells.
8. Glue the white boarder to the top of the card.
9. Then glue the narrow black pieces after measuring from top border to the bell.
10. Tie two real red bows.
11. Next using glue dots and a tape runner adhere the bows just above each bell.
12. Glue the Merry Christmas sentiment between the bells.
13. Glue this piece to one piece of the Real Red Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼ ". Glue this piece to the front of the card base.
14. Glue the inside sentiment to a piece of Real Red Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼ ".
15. Now glue this piece to the inside of the card base.

## Envelope

Using your tape runner put tape on the top side of the flap of the envelope. Carefully lay your piece of DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 2 3/8" x 6" on the flap starting at the fold of the flap. Trim and you are done!
