

This is What You Will Need For The Clever Cats Halloween Card

Paper

- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼"
- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" x 5" for the inside sentiment
- 1 Piece of Pumpkin Pie Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼" (cut after embossing)
- 1 Piece of Pumpkin Pie Cardstock cut to 1 ½" x 2" for sentiment border
- 2 pieces of Basic Black cut to 4" x 5 ¼"

¼ sheet of Basic Black cut to scalloped piece from (largest die from the Stitched So Sweetly die set)

¼ sheet, (4 ¼" x 5 ½") of Basic White Cardstock to cut the 2nd largest scalloped frame from. This is the piece you can stamp the cat and spider on before you run it through the die cutting machine. You should have enough cardstock left to stamp the outside sentiment on.

Instructions

1. Cut all the paper from the list above.
2. Stamp the cat image and spider on a piece of Basic White Cardstock, $\frac{1}{4}$ sheet, ($4\frac{1}{4}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$) as well as the outside sentiment. Think about stamping the sentiment at one end of the cardstock.
3. Stamp the inside sentiment and the bat on the piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to $3\frac{3}{4}'' \times 5''$.
4. Color the box the cat is sitting in with the dark Pumpkin Pie blends.
5. Using the 2nd largest scalloped rectangle die from the Stitched So Sweetly die set, center over cat and run through the die cutting machine. Now using the $1\frac{1}{4}'' \times 1\frac{3}{4}''$ die from the Stitched Rectangle set cut out front sentiment by running through die cutting machine.
6. Use the largest scalloped rectangle die from the Stitched So Sweetly set, cut out a panel of Basic Black cardstock.
7. Take the Pumpkin Pie Cardstock cut to $4'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$ and place inside the Brick & Mortar Embossing Folder. Spritz with a light coat of water just so the image will be more pronounced. Run through die cutting machine. Cut this piece to $4'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$.
8. Now it is time to assemble your card. Glue the panel with the stamped cat to the black panel with scalloped edges.
9. Next glue this panel to the pumpkin pie piece that you just embossed. Make sure your panel has had time to dry. Next glue this panel to a piece of Basic Black cut to $4'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$ and finally glue to the front of the card base.
10. Glue the front sentiment piece to the piece of Pumpkin Pie Cardstock cut to $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2''$. Put dimensionals on the back of this sentiment piece and adhere to the front of the card as shown on the card.
11. Add three Champagne Jewels.

12. Lastly glue the inside sentiment piece to the last piece of basic black and then to the right side of the card base.

Stampin' UP does not sell these but they are very helpful in card making

Reverse tweezers with pointed tip

Tombow Mono sand and rubber eraser combo

Adhesive Remover (2"x2" block"
