

This is What You Will Need For The Happy Holly Day Christmas Card

Paper

- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼"
- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" x 5"
- 1 piece of Soft Suede Cardstock cut to 2" x 3" for 2 pine cones
- 1 piece Real Red Cardstock cut 3 ¼" x 4"
- 1 piece Real Red Cardstock ¾" x 4"
- 1 piece of Basic White Cardstock cut 3" x 4", (for the bird)
- 1 piece Basic White Cardstock ½" x 4" (stamp the Merry Christmas before cutting to this size)
- 1 piece Silver Foil to cut 3" x 3" to cut foliage from using the Forever Flourishing die
- 2 pieces of Evening Evergreen Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼ "
- 1 piece of Soft Succulent cardstock about 4 ¼" x 5 ½" for foliage
- 1 piece Christmas Tidings cut to 3" x 4"

Instructions

1. Cut all the paper from the list above.
2. Stamp the bird on the piece of Basic White Cardstock cut 3" x 4", using the Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color the body of the bird with Dark Smoky Slate Blends. Color beak and feet with Soft Suede Blends. Cut the bird out with a small pair of scissors.
3. Stamp the foliage in Evening Evergreen Ink on the Soft Succulent cardstock
4. Stamp the Merry Christmas in Real Red on a piece of Basic White and cut down to ½" x 4"
5. Stamp the inside sentiment on the Basic White Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" x 5"
6. Stamp the pine cones in Early Espresso on the Soft Suede Cardstock cut to 2" x 3"
7. Now run all the stamped foliage and pine cones using the proper dies through your die cutting machine. Also using the one die from the Flourishing Fern set to cut the piece of silver foliage.
8. Use one piece of Evening Evergreen Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼" and using the Stitched Greenery Die run through the die cutting machine
9. Glue the piece of Christmas Tidings cut to 3" x 4" to the piece of Real Red Cardstock cut 3 ¼" x 4"
10. Glue this piece to the piece of Evening Evergreen with the leaves imprinted on it.
11. Start gluing your pieces of foliage on this piece of cardstock as shown on the card. Add the bird.
12. Lastly add the sentiment by putting dimensionals on the back and placing just below the bird's belly.
13. Glue the inside sentiment piece to the last Evening Evergreen cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼"

Stampin' UP does not sell these but they are very helpful in card making
