

This is What You Will Need For The Tidings & Trimmings Christmas Card

Paper

1 Piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock cut to 5 ½" x 8 ½" scored at 4 ¼"

1 Piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock cut to 3 ¾" x 5" for the inside

1 piece of Mint Macaron 4" x 4" to cut star from

1 Piece of Mint Macaron cut 1 ¼" x 5"

2 Pieces of Mint Macaron Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 ¼"

1 Piece of the Tidings of Christmas Designers Series Paper cut to 3 ¾" x 5"

1 Piece of Silver Specialty Foil cut 1" x 5"

1 Piece of the Tidings of Christmas Designers Series paper cut to 2 ¾" x 6" (Optional to decorate envelope flap)

Instructions

1. Cut all the paper from the list above.
2. Stamp the 4" x 4" piece of Mint Macaron in the center with the sentiment, (It's The Most Wonderful Time of The Year). Place star die over the sentiment making sure the sentiment is in the center of the die. Run through your die cutting machine. Lay aside.
3. Stamp the inside sentiment on the piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock cut to 3 3/4" x 5". Using the Stampin' Seal to adhere the piece of Silver Specialty Foil cut 1" x 5" to the piece of Mint Macaron cut 1 1/4" x 5" glue the foil to the Mint Macaron strip.
4. Now glue the piece of the Tidings of Christmas Designers Series Paper cut to 3 3/4" x 5" to one of the pieces of Mint Macaron Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 1/4".
5. Now take the piece of foil and mint macaron strip and glue to the Tidings of Christmas Designers Series Paper and Mint Macaron cardstock that you just glued together. You should glue it so the star will fit over the center of it.
6. Adhere this front panel to the front of the card base.
7. Glue the inside sentiment piece to the last piece of Mint Macaron Cardstock cut to 4" x 5 1/4". Then take this panel and glue to the inside of the card base on the right side.
8. Put dimensionals on the back of your star and remove protective coverings and place over the foil strip.
9. Add a silver metallic pearl to each point of the star. All finished!

Stampin' UP does not sell these but they are very helpful in card making

Reverse tweezers with pointed tip
Tombow Mono sand and rubber eraser combo
Adhesive Remover (2"x2" block")

Optional Decorating of Envelope Flap

Using your tape runner put tape on the top side of the flap of the envelope. Carefully lay your piece of DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 2 3/8" x 6" on the flap starting at the fold of the flap.

Trim and you are done!
