

## **This is What You Will Need For The Artistically Inked Specialty Card**

### **Paper**

- 1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 5 ½” x 8 ½” scored at 4 ¼”
- 1 Piece of Basic White thick Cardstock cut to 3 ¾” x 5” for the inside sentiment
- 2 Piece of Evening Evergreen Cardstock cut to 4 ” x 5 1/4”
- 2 Piece of Basic White thick Cardstock for front and flower cut to 4 ” x 5 ”

### **Stamps & Dies**

- Artistically Inked Bundle
- Peaceful Moments Cling Stamp Set

### **Ink**

- Evening Evergreen Classic Ink Pad

### **Adhesive**

- Multipurpose Glue

### **Tools**

- Pick A Tool & Brush
- Stamparatus
- Scissors
- Simple Shammy
- Bone Folder
- Paper Trimmer
- Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine

### **Instructions**

1. Cut all the paper from the list above.
2. Using the long stamp, stamp the Basic White thick Cardstock measuring 4 ” x 5 ” in the Evening Evergreen Ink. Cover entire sheet. Now lay the large flower die on this piece and run through the die cutting machine. Lay flower piece aside for another project.

3. Take the other piece of Basic White thick Cardstock measuring 4 " x 5 and using the same large flower die cut another flower out. This time remove all the small pieces.
4. Glue the Evergreen Stamped background that you just cut the flower from to one of the solid Evening Evergreen Cardstock pieces cut to 4 " x 5 1/4". Be careful not to put too much glue on the back of the flower. You can blot off if you need to. Place in the area that is cut out matching the shapes.
5. Now glue to the front card base. You will not have a border down the sides in the Evening Evergreen because the flower is large.
6. Stamp an inside sentiment on the Basic White thick Cardstock cut to 3 3/4" x 5". Glue inside sentiment piece to the last piece of the Evening Evergreen cardstock and adhere to the right inside of the card base.

Reverse tweezers with pointed tip

Tombow Mono sand and rubber eraser combo

Adhesive Remover (2"x2" block"
