

## **This is What You Will Need For The Double Z Fold Christmas Card**

### **Paper**

- 1 Piece of Soft Succulent Cardstock cut in half at 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" (that's half the 11" side)
- 1 Piece of Soft Succulent Cardstock cut to 2 3/8" x 8 1/2" ( use the second half of the sheet for this one and you will have an extra piece for another card)

- 1 piece of Tidings of Christmas DSP cut to 1 7/8" x 5 1/4"
- 1 piece of Tidings of Christmas DSP cut to 4" x 5 1/4"
- 1 piece of Tidings of Christmas DSP cut to 2 1/2" x 4"
- 1 piece of Tidings of Christmas DSP cut to 1 7/8" x 2 1/2"
- 1 piece of Very Vanilla cardstock cut to 1 7/8" x 2 1/2"
- 1 piece of Very Vanilla cardstock about 2" x 4"
- 1 Piece of Tidings of the Christmas DSP Designers Series paper cut to 2 3/8" x 6" (Optional to decorate envelope flap)

### **Stamps**

Peaceful Deer Photopolymer Stamp Set

### **Punch**

Double Oval Punch

### **Ink**

Evening Evergreen Stampin' Pad

### **Embellishments**

Red Rhinestone Basic Jewels

### **Adhesive**

Multipurpose Glue

Stampin' Seal Tape Runner (optional)

### **Tools**

Small Block for Stamping

Scissors  
Simple Shammy  
Bone Folder  
Paper Trimmer

## Instructions

1. Cut and score the full sheet of Soft Succulent Cardstock as shown on the pdf below.
2. Cut the Tidings of Christmas Designer Series Paper as described above.
3. Using the Evening Evergreen, stamp the front sentiment on a small piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock 2" x 4" and using the oval punch you can cut it out.
4. Stamp the inside sentiment on the piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock measuring 1 7/8" x 2 1/2".
5. Take your large piece of Soft Succulent Cardstock and fold on the center line and burnish. Next Fold the left side back away from the larger section and burnish. It maybe easier to view the video to see this section.
6. Now take the smaller piece of Soft Succulent Cardstock and fold in half and burnish. This time leave the longer section on top and fold backward and then fold the last section toward the right to form your Z.
7. Glue the piece of Tidings of Christmas DSP cut to 1 7/8" x 5 1/4" to the front of the large panel. Next take the piece of Tidings of Christmas DSP cut to 4" x 5 1/4" and glue to the right side of the large panel.
8. Glue the piece of Tidings of Christmas DSP cut to 2 1/2" x 4" to the front of the smaller Z .
9. Glue the Tidings of Christmas DSP cut to 1 7/8" x 2 1/2" to the center section of the smaller Z. Lastly glue the small inside sentiment to the right section of the small Z. Glue the oval to the largest section of the small Z.
10. To assemble the 2 Z's Start with the inside sentiment section and glue to the right side of the larger Z. Carefully add glue to only half of the larger section of the small Z. Make sure it is the left side and glue only to the front panel of the larger Z.
11. Now add your Red Rhinestones and you are finished.

## Optional Decorating of Envelope Flap

Using your tape runner put tape on the top side of the flap of the envelope. Carefully lay your piece of DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 2 3/8" x 6" on the flap starting at the fold of the flap. Trim and you are done!

**Stampin' UP does not sell these but they are very helpful in card making**

Adhesive Remover (2"x2" block")
