

## **This is What You Will Need For The Turtle Friends Birthday Card**

### **Paper**

1 Piece of Basic White Cardstock cut to 5 ½” x 8 ½” scored at 4 ¼”

1 Piece of Basic White thick Cardstock cut to 3 ¾” x 5” for the inside sentiment

2 Piece of Mossy Meadow Cardstock cut to 4 ” x 5 1/4”

1 piece of Mossy Meadow Cardstock to cut 5 ½”x 8 ½” to cut larger the banner, scalloped circle as well as sentiment border

1 Piece of the Whimsy and Wonder Designers Series Paper cut 3 ¾” x 5”

½ of 8 1’2” x 5 ½” of Basic White thick cardstock to cut white banner, turtle, and front sentiment

1 Piece of the Whimsy and Wonder Designers Series paper cut to 2 3/8” x 6” ( Optional to decorate envelope flap)

Turtle Friends Bundle

Layering Circle Dies

Garden Birdhouses (this is for the inside sentiment)

### **Ink**

Mossy Meadow Classic Ink Pad

### **Punches**

### **Embellishments**

Brushed Metallic Dots

Stampin’ Seal Tape Runner (optional)

Stamparatus  
Scissors

## Instructions

1. Cut all the paper from the list above.
2. Stamp inside sentiment with Mossy Meadow Ink Pad on the piece of Basic White thick Cardstock cut to  $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" – lay aside
3. From the Basic White thick cardstock measuring  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8 \frac{1}{2}$ ", cut a  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " piece of Basic White Cardstock for the white banner. Stamp the turtle on one end of the piece of Basic White thick cardstock that is left, and stamp the front sentiment on a piece of white cardstock cut to  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " or stamp on a larger piece and then cut to  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{4}$ ". Use the Lovely Label Pick a Punch to trim each end so that your sentiment piece is  $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " long.
4. Taking the round smooth die that cuts a  $2 \frac{5}{8}$ " circle, sharp side down and lay over the turtle. Secure with post-it tape or whatever you use and run through the die cutting machine. Use the corresponding scalloped circle and cut a circle out of the Mossy Meadow cardstock. You will also need to cut a strip that is  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $3 \frac{3}{4}$ ". Cut another strip of the Mossy Meadow  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
5. Now take the white  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " and using the Triple Banner Punch and clip off one end. Take the strip of Mossy Meadow  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " and clip off one end using the same punch.
6. Glue white banner piece to the Mossy Meadow banner piece. Glue the turtle piece to the scalloped Mossy Meadow circle. Glue the outside sentiment to the Mossy Meadow piece that is  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $3 \frac{3}{4}$ ".
7. Glue the polka dot Wimsey and Wonder piece to one piece of the Mossy Meadow measuring 4" x  $5 \frac{1}{4}$ ". Glue the combined banner to the left side of the polka dot panel. Not glue this piece to the card base. Remove the backs from the dimensionals on the circle piece and position near the bottom of the banner. Remove the dimensionals from the sentiment piece and position near the top of the card front.
8. Glue inside sentiment piece to the last piece of the Mossy Meadow cardstock and adhere to the right inside of the card base.
9. Adhere three brushed metallic dots around your turtle on the front and you are done.

### **Optional Decorating of Envelope Flap**

Using your tape runner put tape on the top side of the flap of the envelope. Carefully lay your piece of DSP (Designer Series Paper) measuring 2 3/8" x 6" on the flap starting at the fold of the flap. Trim and you are done!

Reverse tweezers with pointed tip

Tombow Mono sand and rubber eraser combo

Adhesive Remover (2"x2" block")
